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PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Paid for by a half-penny sales tax passed in 2016
- Implemented over the next 40 years
- Expands and improves MARTA's existing bus service
- Includes new transit stations and improvements to existing stations
- Invests in new proposed services and enhancements



ATLANTA CITY DESIGN COORDINATION

- Atlanta City Design is the new framework for the long term growth of the City
- Atlanta's Transportation Plan is the access strategy for Atlanta City Design the blueprint for providing all Atlantans with transportation options to support inclusive growth
- Significant growth is anticipated:
 1.3 million residents & 1.2 million jobs

Create a layered, integrated transportation network.



Create last-mile connectivity via circulators, multi-use paths, and sidewalks.







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

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


