State, and Local regulatory agencies. MARTA complies with additional requirements and standards promulgated by transit organizations.

- **Continual Improvement:** MARTA is committed to enhancing environmental performance through continual improvement of the Environmental Management System.

PURPOSE

The Environmental Management Policy is Authority-wide and applies to MARTA employees and contractors. It guides the development of the ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System (EMS) program and other environmental programs under the stewardship of the Department of Safety and Quality Assurance.

In accordance with the Authority’s safety programs and the Environmental Management System Program Plan, MARTA will establish and maintain comprehensive environmental management programs and systems that ensure full compliance with all applicable federal, state, local environmental laws and regulations.

MARTA is dedicated to making pollution prevention, environmental protection and stewardship; sustainable development; and resource conservation major considerations in locating, designing, constructing, and operating MARTA facilities.

The environmental performance objectives are achieved by:

- Incorporating environmental management considerations into phases of design, construction, and operations.
- Identifying compliance issues associated with the MARTA system providing a way for subsequent elimination, control, or minimization to an acceptable level.
- Instilling an environmental-friendly philosophy throughout MARTA that emphasizes pollution prevention, compliant work practices, and spill prevention.
- Establishing and maintaining written policies, procedures, and rules to ensure compliance with environmental regulatory requirements and other requirements, such as the ISO 14001:2015 Standard, to which MARTA subscribes.
- Developing environmental targets and objectives for chosen environmental aspects, and, reviewing impacts annually, at a minimum, with the EMS team and facility stakeholders included in the scope of EMS.
